## **District 4 Public Health to Host COVID-19 Vaccination Event Saturday, March 27<sup>th</sup> 8AM-5PM**

**LaGrange, Ga. March 23, 2021** – District 4 Public Health will host a COVID-19 vaccination event this Saturday, March 27th from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. at the Troup County School System Bus Depot, located at 100 North Davis Road, LaGrange, GA 30241, in an effort to administer 1,500 shots of the Pfizer vaccine’s first dose.

Adults aged 55 and over, healthcare workers, law enforcement, firefighters, first responders, caregivers, and educators are among those eligible to receive this vaccine, as are people with certain underlying conditions.
