LaGrange Animal Services Assists in Meriwether County Hoarding Investigation

LaGrange, Ga. May 5, 2021 – The City of LaGrange Animal Services is assisting Meriwether County in a hoarding investigation that will recover approximately thirty-five cats and kittens.



Animal Services helped to recover approximately 35 cats

Twenty-five cats were recovered in a Meriwether mobile home Tuesday (5/4). Officers are on the scene today (5/5) trying to recover at least ten more cats and kittens.

LaGrange Animal Services and Harris County Humane Society are currently hosting several of the recovered cats. Eight of these cats will be available for adoption next Wednesday (5/12) at the LaGrange Animal Shelter once they are fixed and current on shots.
