City of LaGrange to Shut Down Half Day Friday, April 23rd to Pick Up Litter Throughout the City, Public & Businesses Invited to Participate

LaGrange, Ga. April 19, 2021 – The City of LaGrange plans to shut down business Friday, April 23rd from 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Hundreds of city employees will be going out into the community’s main thoroughfares to pick up litter.

The April 2018 event was so well-received with employees, citizens and elected leaders, the city began hosting monthly cleanups throughout the city. Since 2018, the city is proud to have partnered with many different community groups, businesses, schools, colleges and individuals in leaving LaGrange better than we found it. The slogan was inspired by the comments by City Councilman Nathan Gaskin who said in a city council meeting, “My mom also told me to leave things better than I found it.”

“Working side by side with employees and community members beautifying our city has been such a rewarding and eye opening experience for me,” said City of LaGrange City Manager Meg Kelsey. “We hope that everyone will consider joining us and dedicate a little time to help us clean up our community.”
