## \*TRAFFIC ALERT\* Panther Way Open to Traffic

*LaGrange, Ga. March 21, 2024* – Panther Way, extending from Ridge Street to Forrest Place is now open to traffic. Construction is complete.

Crews narrowed a portion of the road to control traffic speed in the area. Crews also constructed a portion of The Thread that extended under the CSX railroad bridge.

While the road is now open, please be aware the annual Greenpower USA Diverse Power Grand Prix race event held by the Troup County School System will take place Saturday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Panther Way and Dallis Street near LaGrange College's Callaway Auditorium will be blocked to traffic during the race. After the race, the road will open back up to traffic.

Businesses in the area, including in the Hillside community, remain open to the public.
